Effort and contrivance evaporate like mist over a lake in the morning sun Leaving body, speech and mind at one with the birdsong Simple, present, fresh, ordinary, naked, awake.

This everyday body naturally manifests the loving radiant qualities of a Bodhisattva Whose compassionate heart nobly joins with all beings of higher, lower and equal status Manifesting the three types of confidence - "be decisive, know what is, see clearly" - Rejoicing in fearlessness, generosity and good humour Relaxing in the profound simplicity free of inner and outer Relishing the nondual dance of form with emptiness, emptiness with form in the Unborn, undying space of vajradhatu beyond meeting and parting This luminous sacred mandala of primordially awake Vajra Being.
